As our filming endeavor of the Toking with the DEAD series with Bill Diamond Productions continues, we are taking the next steps in making this a one of kind experience by introducing "The Set". We will be building a virtual town inside the 90,000 square foot Diamond Production studio to be used as an interactive set for all our filming needs, and you can be a part of it.

The "town" will be comprised of buildings and store fronts, streets, alleys, corners and more. When completed, it will be approximately 250 feet in length and comprise of an estimated 15 "blocks" designed specifically for filming Toking with the DEAD's live action series based on the comic books. Each block will be approximately 28 feet in length with a perspective height of three stories, or about 25 feet.



What does this mean to you? Well, you and your business can be a part of this giant set. By Sponsoring a block, or a section of one, businesses can have their "storefront" right in the town we will be using for the filming of the series. This is a unique and one-of-a-kind opportunity to be a part of this ongoing filming endeavor with maximum exposure for you and your business.

SPONSORSHIP LEVELS

Sponsor a Block – A full block is about 28 feet in length complete with signage, window doors etc. and are about 25 feet tall with a perspective of three stories. Each block consists of three sections.

Sponsorships start at - \$9,000 for a third of the block. Sponsor the entire block for \$25,000
